

RIJEČ UREDNIKA

Pandemija virusa „SARS-COV-2“ je u potpunosti izmijenila način života i rada na globalnom nivou. U domenu izdavačke djelatnosti, uzrokovala je gašenje mnogobrojnih, čak i dugogodišnjih projekata i časopisa. Mnogi izdavači su se u novim okolnostima odlučili na publikovanje on-line verzije časopisa. Međutim, Redakcija časopisa *Arhivski pogledi* je uzimajući u obzir značaj štampane verzije časopisa, odlučila se za štampanje drugog broja časopisa *Arhivski pogledi*. Uostalom, i prvi broj časopisa *Arhivski pogledi* je publikovan u još težim okolnostima pandemije koronavirusa, odnosno prve godine ove svjetske pošasti, kada je izazov publikovanja časopisa bio daleko veći nego 2021. godine.

Zahvaljujući odlučnosti i riješenosti Redakcije časopisa imamo zadovoljstvo stručnoj, naučnoj, ali i ostaloj javnosti predstaviti novi, drugi po redu, broj časopisa *Arhivski pogledi*. Radovi koji su publikovani u časopisu su prezentirani na *Međunarodnoj arhivskoj konferenciji 2. Tuzlanski arhivski dani*. Unatoč brojnim teškoćama uzrokovanim pandemijom koronavirusa, pomenuta konferencija je održana 24. i 25. septembra 2021. godine. Kako, na koji način i u kojoj mjeri je pandemija uticala na rad i organizaciju rada u arhivskim ustanovama, te kako su arhivske ustanove odgovorile na pandemiju, bila je aktuelna, očekivana i sasvim opravdana tema Konferencije. Zanimanje za navedenu temu je bilo očekujuće veliko. No, uzimajući u obzir važeće higijensko-epidemiološke mjere i zabrane, Organizacioni odbor je realizaciju Konferencije planirao na nivou maksimalno 50 učesnika. Na Konferenciji, svoja iskustva, dileme i probleme, ali i rješenja, podijelili su istaknuti arhivski i naučni radnici iz Bosne i Hercegovine i nekoliko zemalja okruženja: Slovenije, Hrvatske, Srbije.

Unatoč svim navedenim izazovima, Konferencija je uspješno održana na opće zadovoljstvo svih prisutnih. Učešće eminentnih stručnjaka iz Slovenije i Hrvatske, te istaknutih arhivskih i naučnih radnika iz Bosne i Hercegovine, dali su značajan pečat uspješnosti Konferencije.

Kroz publikovane radove i prezentovane stavove arhivista, informacijskih stručnjaka i historičara, aktuelizirane su teme, ukazano je na iskustva arhivskih ustanova i arhivskih stručnjaka u vrijeme pandemije koronavirusa i na koncu dati određeni prijedlozi i smjernice daljeg djelovanja. Najveći broj izlaganja publikovan je u časopisu *Arhivski pogledi*, br. 2. Izlaganja sa Konferencije pretočena su u radove koji su publikovani u časopisu *Arhivski pogledi*, koji je pred nama. Ukupno je publikovano devet arhivističkih radova, u okviru tematske cjeline *Arhivski članci*, eminentnih stručnjaka iz Bosne i Hercegovine, Slovenije, Hrvatske i Srbije. Navedeni radovi, čine okosnicu ovog stručnog časopisa.

Riječ je o zanimljivim radovima koji se odnose na važne i aktuelne teme. Tako se dr. sc. Vlatka Lemić, (Hrvatska), bavila aktuelnom „pandemijskom“

temom: *Razvoj publike i kreativno predstavljanje arhiva u uvjetima pandemije – iskustva CREARCH projekta*. Dugogodišnji saradnik, eminentni arhivski stručnjak, prof. dr. Miroslav Novak, (Slovenija) istražio je i elaborirao u radu vrlo zanimljivu i aktuelnu temu pod nazivom *Standardizacija opisa arhivskih cjelina i njihovih elemenata*. Aktulenom, pandemijskom temom, na vrlo neobičan i jedinstven način bavio se dr. sc. Ivo Orešković, (Hrvatska), u radu *Ljubav u doba korone, inkluzivnost ljubavi kao pokretača rada arhiviste u uvjetima pandemije*. Referentne i prepoznatljive arhivistice dr. sc. Jasmina Živković i Slobodanka Cvetković, (Srbija) u koautorskom radu *Organizacija rada Vanjske službe Arhiva Požarevac u vremenu pandemije* iznijele su svoja iskustva i prijedloge u vezi organizacije i rada u vremenu pandemije. Osim vrlo dragocjenih iskustava kolega iz Hrvatske, Slovenije i Srbije, svoja iskustva su iznijeli i arhivisti bosanskohercegovačkih arhiva. Istaknuti arhivski stručnjaci: Hatidža Fetahagić, Selma Isić i mr. Adnan Tinjić u zajedničkom istraživanju, bavili su se uticajima pandemije na rad i organizaciju bosanskohercegovačke arhivske službe. Admir Hadrović i Sađida Balta iz Arhiva Federacije Bosne i Hercegovine, svoja iskustva vezana za izazove rada u vremenu pandemije u Arhivu Federacije Bosne i Hercegovine iznijeli u koautorskom radu pod nazivom *Organizacija rada Arhiva Federacije Bosne i Hercegovine u vremenu pandemije*. Mr. sc. Omer Zulić iz Arhiva Tuzlanskog kantona, u radu pod nazivom *Izazovi arhivske službe u vremenu pandemije-iskustva Arhiva Tuzlanskog kantona*, bavio se uticajem pandemije na sveukupne rezultate i rad Arhiva Tuzlanskog kantona. Budući da je pandemija koronavirusa imala znatne posljedice u domenu dostupnosti arhivske građe u arhivima za istraživanje, to je u časopisu *Arhivski pogledi* publikovan rad mladog istraživača, mr. Jasmina Jajčevića. U radu pod nazivom *Refleksije pandemije na dostupnost korištenja arhivske građe u arhivima*, ukazuje se na nezavidan položaj istraživača u vremenu pandemije, budući da je rad sa korisnicima usluga arhiva, sveden na minimum.

U rubrici *Historijska građa* publikovan je rad istaknutog historičara, prof. dr. Seada Selimovića, koji se u svom naučnom radu bavio aktuelnom historijskom temom: *Zvornik od 1991. do 2013. godine: Promjene u etničkoj strukturi stanovništva pod utjecajem rata protiv Republike Bosne i Hercegovine*. Kako je cilj časopisa da kroz rubriku *Historijska građa* publikuje radove kojima se prezentuju historijski izvori, to se redakcija časopisa odlučila da u drugom broju publikuje rad Jusufa Džafića. Radi se o zanimljivom radu pod nazivom *Neknjižna i efemerna građa iz legata Ševket-ef. Šabića u Specijalnoj biblioteci „Behram-beg“ u Tuzli*. Ovim radom smo nastojali ovu vrijednu zbirku prezentirati i približiti svim potencijalnim istraživačima i iste zainteresirati za korištenje iste.

U rubrici *Nova izdanja* predstavljeno je nekoliko vrijednih publikacija iz oblasti arhivistike i historije. Radi se o izdanjima koja su, u najvećem broju, publikovana 2021. godine, te predstavljaju značajan doprinos arhivistici i historiografiji Bosne i Hercegovine.

Rubrika *Novosti* donosi izvještaj o realizaciji *Međunarodne arhivske konferencije 2. Tuzlanski arhivski dani*, te izvještaj sa *Međunarodnog arhivističkog savjetovanja „Novi Sad 2021“*, u organizaciji Arhivističkog društva Srbije, održanog u Novom Sadu, 6-8.10.2021. godine. Na kraju časopisa donijete su biobibliografije autora i saradnika časopisa, te upute saradnicima.

U drugom broju časopisa štampana su ukupno dvadesetdva rada, autora iz Bosne i Hercegovine, Srbije, Hrvatske, Slovenije i Sjeverne Makedonije.

Značajno je napomenuti da je i novi, drugi po redu broj časopisa *Arhivski pogledi* štampan u specifičnim i otežanim okolnostima. Međutim, zahvaljujući Društvu arhivskih zaposlenika Tuzlanskog kantona, te agilnim članovima Organizacionog odbora, Redakcije časopisa, recenzentima, urednicima, lektorima, prevodiocima i ovaj broj je iako u teškim uslovima ugledao svjetlo dana. Stoga isti sa radošću prepuštamo cjelokupnoj stručnoj, naučnoj i široj javnosti.

Potrebno je napomenuti da je drugi broj časopisa štampan uz finansijsku podršku Federalnog ministarstva obrazovanja i nauke, te Fondacije za izdavaštvo Sarajevo, na čemu im se iskreno zahvaljujemo.

A WORD FROM THE EDITOR

The “SARS-COV-2” pandemic has completely changed the way we live and work globally. In the field of publishing, it caused the closure of many, even long-term projects and journals. In the new circumstances, many publishers decided to publish an online version of their journals. However, the Editorial Board of the journal *Archival Views* (*Arhivski pogledi*), taking into account the importance of the printed version of the journal, decided to print another issue. After all, the first issue of the journal *Archival Views* was published in even more difficult circumstances of the coronavirus pandemic, i.e. the first year of this world plague, when the challenge of publishing the journal was far greater than in 2021.

Thanks to the determination of the Editorial Board of the journal, we are pleased to present to the professional, scientific and other public the new, second in a row, issue of the journal *Archival Views*. Papers published in the journal were presented at the *2nd International Archival Conference „Tuzla’s Archival Days”*. Despite numerous difficulties caused by the coronavirus pandemic, the mentioned conference was held on September 24 and 25, 2021. How, in what way and to what extent the pandemic affected the work and organization of work in archival institutions, and how archival institutions responded to the pandemic, was the current, expected and completely justified topic of the Conference. Interest in this topic was, as expected, great. However, taking into account the current hygienic-epidemiological measures and prohibitions, the Organizing Committee planned the realization of the Conference at the level of a maximum of 50 participants. At the Conference, their experiences, dilemmas and problems, but also solutions, were shared by prominent archival and scientific workers from Bosnia and Herzegovina and several neighbouring countries: Slovenia, Croatia and Serbia.

Despite all these challenges, the Conference was successfully held to the general satisfaction of all participants. The participation of eminent experts from Slovenia and Croatia, as well as prominent archival and scientific workers from Bosnia and Herzegovina, gave a significant boost to the success of the Conference.

Through published works and presented attitudes of archivists, information experts and historians, topics were updated, the experiences of archival institutions and archival experts during the coronavirus pandemic were pointed out, and finally certain suggestions and guidelines for further action were given. The largest number of presentations were published in the journal *Archival Views* no. 2. Presentations from the Conference were translated into papers published in the journal *Archival Views*, which is before us. A total of nine archival papers have been published, within the thematic unit titled *Archival Articles*, by eminent experts from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Slovenia, Croatia and Serbia. These papers are the backbone of this professional journal.

These are interesting works related to important and current topics. So dr. sc. Vlatka Lemić, (Croatia), dealt with the current „pandemic“ topic: *Audience development and creative presentation of archives in a pandemic – the experience of the CREARCH project*. Long-term associate, eminent archival expert, prof. dr. Miroslav Novak (Slovenia) researched and elaborated a very interesting and current topic entitled *Standardization of the description of archival units and their elements*. The current, pandemic topic was dealt with in a very unusual and unique way by dr. sc. Ivo Orešković, (Croatia), in the work *Love in the Age of the Corona, the inclusiveness of love as the initiator of the work of archivists in the conditions of a pandemic*. Referenced and recognizable archivists dr. sc. Jasmina Živković and Slobodanka Cvetković, (Serbia) in the co-authored work *Organization of the External Service of the Požarevac Archives during the pandemic* presented their experiences and proposals regarding the organization and work during the pandemic. In addition to the very valuable experiences of colleagues from Croatia, Slovenia and Serbia, archivists from the archives of Bosnia and Herzegovina also shared their experiences. Prominent archival experts: Hatidža Fetahagić, Selma Isić and mr. Adnan Tinjić, in a joint research, dealt with the effects of the pandemic on the work and organization of the Bosnian archival service. Admir Hadrović and Sađida Balta from the Archives of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina presented their experiences related to the challenges of working during the pandemic in the Archives of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina in a co-authored paper entitled *Organization of the Archives of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina during the pandemic*. Mr. sc. Omer Zulić from the Archives of Tuzla Canton, in the paper entitled *Challenges of the Archives Service during the pandemic-experience of the Archives of Tuzla Canton*, dealt with the impact of the pandemic on the overall results and work of the Archives of Tuzla Canton. Since the coronavirus pandemic had significant consequences in the field of availability of archival material in research archives, the work of a young researcher, mr. Jasmin Jajčević, was published in the journal as the paper entitled *Reflections on the pandemic on the availability of archival material in archives* which points to the unenviable position of researchers during the pandemic, since work with users of archival services has been reduced to a minimum.

The section *Historical Records*, includes the paper of a prominent historian, prof. dr. Sead Selimović, who in his scientific work dealt with the current historical topic: *Zvornik from 1991 to 2013: Changes in the ethnic structure of the population under the influence of the war against the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina*. As the aim of the journal is to publish works presenting historical sources through the section *Historical Records*, the editorial board of the journal also decided to publish the work of Jusuf Džafić in the second issue. This is an interesting work entitled *Non-book and ephemeral material from the legacy of Ševket eff. Šabić in the Special Library „Behrambeg“ in Tuzla*. With this work, we tried to present this valuable collection and bring it closer to all potential researchers and make them interested in using it.

The *Newly Published* section presents several valuable publications in the field of archival science and history. These are the editions that were, in the largest number, published in 2021, and represent a significant contribution to archival science and historiography of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

The *News* section brings a report on the realization of the *International Archival Conference „2nd Tuzla’s Archival Days”*, and a report from the *International Archival Conference „Novi Sad 2021“*, organized by the Archival Association of Serbia, held in Novi Sad, from 6th to 8th of October 2021. At the end of the journal, we can find biographies of the authors and contributors of the journal, as well as instructions for contributors.

In the second issue of the journal published a total of twenty-two works by authors from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia, Croatia, Slovenia and Northern Macedonia.

It is important to note that the new, second issue of the journal *Archival Views* was published in specific and difficult circumstances. However, thanks to the Association of Archival Employees of Tuzla Canton, and devoted members of the Organizing Committee, the Editorial Board, reviewers, editors, proof-readers and translators, this issue, despite difficult conditions, saw the light of day. Therefore, we gladly present it to the entire professional, scientific and general public.

It should be noted that the second issue of the journal was printed with the financial support of the Federal Ministry of Education and Science and the Publishing Foundation Sarajevo, for which we sincerely thank them.
