

## RIJEČ UREDNIKA

Društvo arhivskih zaposlenika Tuzlanskog kantona ima zadovoljstvo prezentirati stručnoj, prevashodno arhivističkoj, zatim naučnoj, prvenstveno historijskoj, te ostaloj javnosti, novi, po redu treći broj časopisa *Arhivski pogledi*. Radi se o časopisu koji je rezultat realizacije Međunarodne arhivske konferencije pod nazivom „3. Tuzlanski arhivski dani“, koja je realizirana 23. i 24. septembra 2022. godine, u Hotelu Senad od Bosne, na jezeru Modrac, Lukavac. Uzimajući u obzir činjenicu da Društvo arhivskih zaposlenika Tuzlanskog kantona, i mnogobrojna druga strukovna, arhivska udruženja, organizirana na različitim nivoima vlasti u Bosni i Hercegovini, ali i u zemljama regiona, decenijama daju nesebičan doprinos razvoju i unapređenju arhivskih službi i arhivske djelatnosti, opredijelila je Organizacioni odbor konferencije da tema konferencije „3. Tuzlanski arhivski dani“ bude *Arhivske asocijacije – značaj i doprinos razvoju i unapređenju arhivá i arhivske djelatnosti*.

Navedenom konferencijom, željelo se kroz izlaganja arhivista iz Bosne i Hercegovine i zemalja regije, argumentirano predstaviti rezultate i iskustva vezana za doprinos arhivskih asocijacija u razvoju i unapređenju rada arhivá i arhivskih službi. Izlaganja bosanskohercegovačkih, ali i eminentnih arhivskih i naučnih radnika iz zemalja regije, evidentno su potvrdila značajan doprinos arhivskih stručnih asocijacija, posebno u dijelu realizacije edukativnih programa za arhivske kadrove u arhivima i registraturama, realizaciji stručnih i naučnih konferencija, međunarodnih i međuarhivskih projekata saradnje, izložbenih aktivnosti, naučno-istraživačkih projekata, publikovanja stručnih i naučnih publikacija, saradnje sa arhivskim, kulturnim i drugim srodnim ustanovama i institucijama, doprinos unapređenju i harmonizaciji zakonske regulative i drugih aktuelnih tema.

Navedena tema očekivano je izazvala veliko interesovanje, kako bosanskohercegovačkih, tako i arhivista izvan Bosne i Hercegovine. U skladu sa koncepcijom konferencije, dogovoreno je da ispred svakog arhivističkog društva iz Bosne i Hercegovine i zemalja regije učestvuje po jedan izlagač, koji će iznijeti iskustva i rezultate rada, te predstaviti njihov doprinos razvoju, unapređenju i popularizaciji arhivske građe i arhivske djelatnosti i kulturnog naslijeđa uopće. Stoga su na navedenoj konferenciji učestvovali i izlagali eminentni arhivski stručnjaci i naučni radnici, svih bosanskohercegovačkih arhivističkih udruženja (Arhivističko udruženje Bosne i Hercegovine, Arhivističko udruženje u Federaciji Bosne i Hercegovine, Udruženje arhivskih radnika Republike Srpske, Društvo arhivskih zaposlenika Tuzlanskog kantona, Društvo arhivskih radnika Unsko-sanskog kantona), te predstavnici arhivističkih udruženja zemalja regiona i to: ICARUS Hrvatska, Hrvatsko arhivističko društvo, Arhivsko društvo Slovenije i Arhivističko društvo Srbije. Na konferenciji je prezentirano ukupno 14 radova, kojima je argumentirano i naučno prezentiran i dokazan značajan doprinos navedenih stručnih arhivskih asocijacija sveukupnom razvoju i

unapređenju arhiva i arhivskih službi kako u Bosni i Hercegovini, tako i u zemljama regiona. Nažalost, do zaključenja časopisa, konačne verzije radova nisu stigli dostaviti svi izlagači, koji su učestvovali i izlagali radove na pomenutoj konferenciji.

Nakon realizacije konferencije malobrojni, ali vrijedni redakcijski tim časopisa, zajedno sa uvažanim i eminentnim recenzentima, nastavio je posao na pripremi radova za publikovanje. U trećem broju časopisa publikovano je ukupno 19 radova eminentnih arhivskih i naučnih stručnjaka iz Bosne i Hercegovine, Hrvatske, Srbije, Slovenije i Crne Gore. U konceptijskom smislu radovi su podijeljeni u već prepoznatljive rubrike časopisa. Budući da je časopis *Arhivski pogledi* težišno arhivistički časopis, to je najveći broj radova (prezentiranih na konferenciji) publikovan u okviru rubrike *Arhivski članci*. Naime, ukupno je u okviru pomenute rubrike publikovano deset radova. Radi se o radovima, koji su po ocjenama recenzenata u najvećem omjeru naučni, te u manjoj mjeri stručni radovi. Tako je u okviru pomenute rubrike publikovan rad uvažene arhiviste i naučne radnice dr. sc. Vlatke Lemić, (ICARUS Hrvatska/Sveučilište u Zagrebu), koja je u radu pod nazivom *Profesionalizacija i opstojnost arhivske struke u suvremenom društvu: Doprinos udruga razvoju kompetencija i znanja* istražila i analizirala doprinos udruga razvoju kompetencija i znanja, pri tome se referirajući prevashodno na međunarodne arhivske asocijacije (ICA i ICARUS). O *aktivnostima Arhivističkog društva Srbije na unapređenju struke (1954-2022)*, u svom radu bavile su se već afirmirane arhiviste: Slobodanka Cvetković (Istorijski arhiv Požarevac, Srbija) i Lela Pavlović (Međuopštinski istorijski arhiv Čačak, Srbija). O *značaju Arhivističkog udruženja Bosne i Hercegovine za edukaciju arhivskog kadra kroz projekat Savjetovanjá*, istražila je i u svom radu predočila mr. Spomenka Pelić (Kantonalni arhiv Travnik). Najznačajniji izdavački projekat na nivou Arhivističkog udruženja Bosne i Hercegovine jeste časopis *Glasnik arhivâ i Arhivističkog udruženja Bosne i Hercegovine*. O značaju i doprinosu navedenog časopisa u radu, pod nazivom *Doprinos Glasnika arhivâ i Arhivističkog udruženja Bosne i Hercegovine razvoju i unapređenju arhivske službe Bosne i Hercegovine* bavio se mr. sc. Omer Zulić (Arhiv Tuzlanskog kantona, Bosna i Hercegovina). Uvažene kolegice mr. Marijana Todorović-Bilić i Vesna Đaić-Škondrić (Arhiv Republike Srpske, Bosna i Hercegovina), analizirale su i obradile temu *Doprinos Udruženja arhivskih radnika Republike Srpske razvoju arhivske djelatnosti i promociji arhivske građe kao kulturnog dobra*. Osim entitetskih, u časopisu su obrađene i teme u kojima je analiziran doprinos kantonalnih udruženja razvoju i unapređenju arhiva i arhivske službe Bosne i Hercegovine. Kolega Husein Hadžić (Arhiv Unsko-sanskog kantona, Bosna i Hercegovina), bavio se pitanjem *Društveno korisne aktivnosti Društva arhivskih radnika Unsko-sanskog kantona*. Evidentno veliki doprinos razvoju i unapređenju arhiva i arhivske službe Bosne i Hercegovine, ali i historiografije Bosne i Hercegovine dalo je Društvo arhivskih zaposlenika Tuzlanskog kantona kroz raznovrsne stručne i naučne sadržaje i projekte. Dva značajna rada publikovana u trećem broju časopisa odnose se na koautorske radove ispred

organizatora konferencije, odnosno Društva arhivskih zaposlenika Tuzlanskog kantona. Tako se koautorski tim u sastavu mr. Adnan Tinjić i Hatidža Fetahagić, bavio temom *Edukacija arhivskih kadrova kroz projekte Društva arhivskih zaposlenika Tuzlanskog kantona*. Kolege, arhivisti, mr. Jasmin Jajčević (Centar za istraživanje moderne i savremene historije Tuzla, Bosna i Hercegovina) i Selma Isić (Društvo arhivskih zaposlenika Tuzlanskog kantona, Bosna i Hercegovina) istražili su i analizirali temu pod nazivom *Izdavačka djelatnost Društva arhivskih zaposlenika Tuzlanskog kantona u funkciji unapređenja arhivske struke i historijske nauke*. Temom neobičnog naziva, *Put putuje Nuh aga Ivo*, bavio se kolega dr. sc. Ivo Orešković (Državni arhiv u Dubrovniku, Hrvatska). U časopisu je publikovan i vrlo aktuelan i zanimljiv rad istaknutog arhivskog i informacijskog stručnjaka, prof. dr. Miroslava Novaka (Pokrajinski arhiv Maribor, Slovenija) pod nazivom *Statistika i statističke metode u savremenoj arhivskoj teoriji i praksi*.

Budući da je jedan od ciljeva časopisa *Arhivski pogledi* da kroz rubriku *Historijska građa* publikuje radove koji su nastali na osnovu istraživanja arhivske građe, kao historijskih izvora prvog reda, to je u trećem broju časopisa publikovan rad istaknutog naučnog radnika, ali i arhiviste, prof. dr. Seada Selimovića (Univerzitet Tuzli, Bosna i Hercegovina). Profesor Selimović je na osnovu arhivske građe istražio i naučno obradio temu pod nazivom *Bijeljina od zadnjih decenija osmanlijske vlasti do kraja austro-ugarske uprave (1851-1918): demografske i socijalne promjene*. Eminentni arhivski stručnjak, te istaknuti naučni radnik prof. dr. Izet Šabotić (Univerzitet u Tuzli, Bosna i Hercegovina) u radu (i izlaganju na konferenciji) bavio se istraživanjem teme *Doprinos časopisa Arhivska praksa razvoju bosanskohercegovačke historiografije*, iz kojih razloga je isti i publikovan u okviru rubrike *Historijska građa*. Redakcija časopisa se također opredjelila da u trećem broju časopisa publikuje rad mr. Jasmina Jajčevića, koji se odnosi na prezentaciju arhivske građe pohranjene u Arhivu Tuzlanskog kantona. Publikovan je rad pod nazivom *Zbirka plakata Arhiva Tuzlanskog kantona (značaj i specifičnost obrade)*. Kroz navedeni rad smo nastojali ovu značajnu zbirku prezentirati i približiti svim potencijalnim istraživačima.

U rubrici *Nova izdanja* predstavljeno je nekoliko značajnih publikacija iz oblasti arhivistike i historije. Radi se o izdanjima koja su publikovana 2021. i 2022. godine, koja predstavljaju značajan doprinos arhivistici i arhivskoj djelatnosti, te historiografiji Bosne i Hercegovine.

U rubrici *Novosti* štampan je izvještaj o realizaciji Međunarodne arhivske konferencije 3. *Tuzlanski arhivski dani*, kao i prestižne naučne konferencije pod nazivom *450 godina Gazi Turali-begova vakufa*. Na kraju časopisa donijete su biografije autora radova, te upute saradnicima.

Zahvaljujući malobrojnom, ali odabranom timu Društva arhivskih zaposlenika Tuzlanskog kantona, odgovornim i angažiranim članovima Organizacionog odbora, Redakcije časopisa, recenzentima, urednicima,

lektorima, prevodiocima i ovaj broj je ugledao svjetlo dana. Stoga isti sa radošću prepuštamo na čitanje i ocjenu cjelokupnoj stručnoj, naučnoj i široj javnosti.

Treći broj časopisa *Arhivski pogledi* štampan je uz finansijsku podršku Fondacije za izdavačku djelatnost Sarajevo, na čemu im se iskreno zahvaljujemo.

## A WORD FROM THE EDITOR

The Association of Archival Employees of the Tuzla Canton is pleased to present to the professional, primarily archival, then scientific and historical as well as the general public, new, third issue of the journal „Archival Views”. It is a journal that is the result of the realization of the International archival conference titled „Third Tuzla's Archival Days”, which was realized on September 23 and 24, 2022, at the Hotel „Senad od Bosne” (Lake Modrac, Lukavac). Taking into account the fact that the Association of Archival Employees of the Tuzla Canton, and numerous other professional, archival associations, are organized at different levels of government in Bosnia and Herzegovina, but also in the countries of the region, have for decades made a selfless contribution to the development and improvement of archival services and archival activity, organizers decided that the theme of the conference „Third Tuzla's Archival Days” would be *Archival associations - significance and contribution to the development and improvement of archives and archival activity*.

With the aforementioned conference, the aim was to present the results and experiences related to the contribution of archival associations in the development and improvement of the work of archives and archival services through the presentations of archivists from Bosnia and Herzegovina and the countries of the region. Presentations by Bosnia and Herzegovina, as well as eminent archival and scientific workers from the countries of the region, evidently confirmed the significant contribution of archival professional associations, especially in the part of the implementation of educational programs for archival staff in archives and registries, the realization of professional and scientific conferences, international and inter-archival cooperation projects, exhibitions activities, scientific research projects, publication of professional and scientific publications, cooperation with archival, cultural and other related institutions and institutions, contribution to the improvement and harmonization of legal regulations and other current topics.

As expected, the mentioned topic garnered significant interest, both from Bosnia and Herzegovina and from archivists outside of Bosnia and Herzegovina. In accordance with the concept of the conference, it was agreed that in front of each archival association from Bosnia and Herzegovina and the countries of the region, one representative will be present and introduce the experiences and results as well as their contribution to the development, improvement and popularization of archival material and cultural heritage in general. Therefore, eminent archival experts and scientific workers from all archival associations active in Bosnia and Herzegovina (Archival Association of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Archival Association in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Association of Archival Employees of Republika Srpska, Association of Archival Employees of Tuzla Canton, Association of Archival Employees of

Una-Sana Canton) participated and presented their lectures at the mentioned Conference. Also, representatives of the archival associations of the countries of the region, namely: ICARUS Croatia, the Croatian Archivist Society, the Archival Association of Slovenia and the Archivist Association of Serbia also participated in the conference. A total of 14 papers were presented, which argued, scientifically presented and proved the significant contribution of the aforementioned professional archival associations to the overall development and improvement of archives and archival services both in Bosnia and Herzegovina and in the countries of the region. Unfortunately, by the time the journal was prepared for printing, not all lecturers who participated and presented their papers at the aforementioned conference could deliver the final versions of their papers.

After the conference, current editorial team of the journal, together with respected and eminent reviewers, continued the work of preparing papers for publication. In the third issue of the journal, a total of 19 works by eminent archival and scientific experts from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Serbia, Slovenia and Montenegro were published. Conceptually, the works are divided into already recognizable sections of the journal. Since the journal „Archival Views” is primarily an archival journal, the largest number of papers (presented at the Conference) is published under the section *Archival articles*. Namely, a total of ten works were published within the aforementioned section. These are works that, according to the reviewers' evaluations, are mostly scientific and, to a lesser extent, professional works. Thus, within the aforementioned column, the work of the respected archivist and scientist Vlatka Lemić, (ICARUS Croatia/University of Zagreb), who in the paper entitled *Professionalization and survival of the archival profession in contemporary society: The contribution of associations to the development of competences and knowledge* investigated and analyzed the contribution of associations to the development of competences and knowledge, referring primarily to international archival associations (ICA and ICARUS). Already established archivists: Slobodanka Cvetković (Historical Archive Požarevac, Serbia) and Lela Pavlović (Inter-Municipal Historical Archive Čačak, Serbia) dealt with *the activities of the Archivist Society of Serbia* aimed to improve the profession (1954-2022). Spomenka Pelić (Travnik Cantonal Archives) researched and presented details about *the significance of the Archival Association of Bosnia and Herzegovina for the education of archival staff through the Counseling project*. The most significant publishing project at the level of the Archival Association of Bosnia and Herzegovina is the journal „Glasnik arhiva i Arhivističkog društva Bosne i Hercegovine”. The paper authored by Omer Zulić (Archives of Tuzla Canton, Bosnia and Herzegovina) and titled as *Contribution of the Herald of Archives and the Archivist Association of Bosnia and Herzegovina to the development and improvement of the archival service of Bosnia and Herzegovina* speaks about the importance and contribution of the mentioned journal. Our dear colleagues, Marijana Todorović-Bilić and Vesna Đaić-Škondrić (Archives of the Republic of Srpska, Bosnia and

Herzegovina), analyzed and presented on the subject of *Contribution of the Association of Archival Employees of the Republika Srpska to the development of archival activity and the promotion of archival material as a cultural asset*. In addition to entities, the journal also covers topics that examine the contribution of cantonal associations to the development and improvement of the archives and archival service of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Colleague Husein Hadžić (Archives of the Una-Sana Canton, Bosnia and Herzegovina), dealt with the issue of socially useful activities of the Association of *Archival Employees* of the Una-Sana Canton. Evidently, a great contribution to the development and improvement of the archives and archival service of Bosnia and Herzegovina, as well as the historiography of Bosnia and Herzegovina, was made by the Association of Archival Employees of the Tuzla Canton through various professional and scientific contents and projects. Two significant papers published in this issue of the journal refer to co-authored works by the conference's organizers. Thus, the co-author team consisting of Adnan Tinjić and Hatidža Fetahagić dealt with the topic of Education of archival personnel through the projects of the Association of Archival Employees of the Tuzla Canton. Archivists, Jasmin Jajčević (Center for the Research of Modern and Contemporary History, Bosnia and Herzegovina) and Selma Isić (Association of Archival Employees of Tuzla Canton, Bosnia and Herzegovina) researched and analyzed the topic entitled *Publishing activity of the Association of Archive Employees of Tuzla Canton in the function of improving the archival profession and historical science*. The topic of the unusual name, The Road Traveled by Nuh aga Ivo, was penned by colleague Ivo Orešković (State Archives in Dubrovnik, Croatia). The journal also published a very current and interesting work by a prominent archival and information expert, prof. dr. Miroslav Novak (Provincial Archives Maribor, Slovenia) entitled *Statistics and statistical methods in contemporary archival theory and practice*.

Since one of the goals of the journal „Archival Views” is to publish works based on the research of archival materials, as historical sources of the first order, through the section *Historical records*, it is the work of a prominent scientific worker and archivist, prof. dr. Sead Selimović (University of Tuzla, Bosnia and Herzegovina). Based on archival material, Professor Selimović researched and scientifically presented on the topic *Bijeljina from the last decades of the Ottoman rule to the end of the Austro-Hungarian administration (1851-1918): demographic and social changes*. Eminent archival expert and distinguished scientific worker prof. dr. Izet Šabotić (University of Tuzla, Bosnia and Herzegovina) in his work (and presentation at the Conference) dealt with research on the topic *Contribution of the journal Archival practice to the development of Bosnian historiography*, for which reasons it was also published under the section *Historical records*. The editors of the journal also decided to publish the work of Jasmin Jajčević, which refers to the presentation of archival materials stored in the Archives of the Tuzla Canton. The paper itself is titled *Collection of posters of the Tuzla Canton Archives (importance and specificity*

*of processing*) was published. Through this work, we tried to present this significant collection and bring it closer to all potential researchers.

Several important publications in the field of archival science and history are presented in the section *Newly Published*. These are publications released in 2021 and 2022, which represent a significant contribution to archivists and archival activities, as well as to the historiography of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

The final section, *News*, includes a report from international conference „3rd Tuzla Archival Days”, as well as the prestigious scientific conference titled „450 years of Gazi Turali-beg' waqf”. At the end of the journal, there are biographies of the authors, as well as instructions for collaborators.

Thanks to the small but selected team of the Association of Archival Employees of the Tuzla Canton, responsible and committed members of the Organizing Committee, the Editorial Board of the journal, reviewers, editors, proofreaders, and translators, this issue saw the light of day. Therefore, we are happy to leave it to the entire professional, scientific and general public to read and evaluate.

The third issue of the journal „Archival Views” was printed with the financial support of the Publishing Foundation Sarajevo, for which we sincerely thank them.
